1. Applicant-wife seeks transfer of petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing HMA No.3228 of 2019 titled as “Deepak Kumar Verma Vs. Chandar Kala” pending in the Court of Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant-petitioner is residing at Hoshiarpur with her parents. The distance between Ludhiana and Hoshiarpur is about 90 Kms. She has no source of income. Therefore, it is very difficult for her to go to Ludhiana on each date of hearing.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have

gone through the record of the case.

4. The case pending between the parties is aftermath of matrimonial discord.

5. Learned counsel for the applicant also relies upon judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in case titled ***Sumita Singh Vs. Kumar Sanjay and another, AIR 2002 SC 396***, wherein it is held that transfer of matrimonial proceedings initiated by the husband against wife, convenience of the wife ought to be looked into.

6. In the premise, present application is allowed. The petition in question pending before the Court of learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana is ordered to be withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to the District Judge, Hoshiarpur for its disposal in accordance with law by the Court concerned.
