HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has not been given the benefit of work-charge service, which he had rendered prior to the regularization of his service as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits. The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant the benefit of work-charge service and re-compute the pensionary benefits along with arrears.

Learned Sr. counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents states that during the pendency of the present writ petition, all the pensionary benefits which the petitioner has claimed in the present writ petition, have already been extended to him and the petitioner has been granted the benefits of work-charge service as qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits and even the arrears have been allowed in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as the arrears in respect of the revised pensionary benefits have already been extended to the petitioner in October, 2019, she does not press the present writ petition and the same may be disposed of as having been not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.
