Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had filed a complaint against the private respondents by stating that the private respondents had caused injuries to the family members of the petitioner including the wife of the petitioner namely, Bikramjit Kaur and the same was brought to the notice of the police authorities. The Police authorities did not take any action on the same and rather private respondents are now pressurising the petitioner and his family members to compromise the matter. He has further submitted that private respondents also stand in the front of the house of the petitioner with deadly weapons and

they are doing the same from the last number of days and do not let the family come out of their house and they are in fact locked in their own house because of the fear caused in the mind of the petitioner and his family members by the private respondents. He has submitted that he will be satisfied in case appropriate direction can be issued to the police authorities to consider the threat perception of the petitioner and his family members.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh Dulat, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the aforesaid respondents and submits that State has no objection in case appropriate direction is issued to consider the representation of the petitioner with regard to the threat perception to him and his family members regarding their life and liberty.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representation which has been made by the petitioner vide Annexure P-1 and shall also consider the threat perception of the petitioner and his family members and in case the need arises then he would take appropriate action in accordance with law.
