Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.327 dated 20.08.2020 under Section 148, 149, 323, 506, 325 & 307 IPC 1860, Police Station Kalanaur, Rohtak. He apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police in the above said FIR.

On 08.12.2020 the following order was passed:-

“Case taken up through video conferencing.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 22.12.2020.

The State counsel is directed to file written response to the petition giving the stage of the case whether it is still being investigated or challan has been filed. It is further informed as to whether the petitioner is involved in any other criminal case, if so, the particulars thereof, be given.

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In compliance to the said order, reply by way of affidavit of Sh.

Vinod Kumar, H.P.S., Dy. Superintendent of Police, Rohtak on behalf of respondent-State has been filed. The same is taken on record.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel that the injuries suffered by the victim on his head resulted in fracture and was declared dangerous to life whereupon the offence under Section 307 IPC was added.

Considering the allegations and the seriousness of the offence, this Court does not find it a fit case for grant of extra ordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
