This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct fair, impartial and expeditious investigation in case FIR No.374 dated 29.10.2020 under Sections 148, 323, 427, 452 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 30.11.2020 to respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/4, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, to look into and decide representation dated 30.11.2020 (Annexure P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
