This Civil Revision under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking direction to respondent No.1 and 2 to deliver possession of the property which fell to his share in the partition proceedings, which have become final. It has been pleaded that the petitioner filed an application for execution of the warrants of possession on 28.09.2020. However, no action thereon has been taken.

Ms. Anju Arora, Addl. A.G. Punjab has appeared for respondent Nos.1 and 2 and submits that the warrants of possession have already been issued and since there was apprehension of breach of peace, therefore, the police help has been sought. She submits that the possession shall be delivered to the petitioner within a period of one week from today.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statement, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the revision petition be disposed of.
