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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

The petitioner claims that he is a senior citizen and retired as District Homeopathic Officer from the Department of Homeopathy. He sold a portion of his house to respondent No. 5 for Rs. 15,05,000/-. The grievance of petitioner is that as respondent No. 5 has not paid him entire sale consideration and Rs. 2,00,000/- is still pending towards him, but respondent No. 4 has been threatening petitioner to vacate the portion of house in his possession. Petitioner has submitted representations (Annexure P-1 to Annexure P-4) addressed amongst others to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (respondent No. 2) giving details of mobile phone numbers whereby respondent No. 5 was giving threats to him but no action thereon has been taken. Petitioner apprehends danger to his life from respondent No. 5.

Without commenting anything on the merits of case and opining on the veracity of claim of petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into representations (Annexure P-1 to Annexure P-4) and take such action as may be warranted in law.
