Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.183 dated 23.08.2020 registered at Police Station Siwan, District Kaithal, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 325, 427, 452 and 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the contents of the FIR, the the petitioner along with other accused had allegedly inflicted injuries on the nine persons from the complainant-party. It is further contended that though the petitioner was allegedly holding a 'gandasi', yet no specific injury has been attributed to him.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Jai Bhagwan of Police Station Siwan, District Kaithal, while opposing the prayer for grant of bail, points out that in his statement recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C., injured Ramphal has specifically stated that the petitioner had caused an injury on his head with the reverse side of the

gandasi held by him. It is further submitted that as per the opinion of the Doctor, injury No.1 caused on the person of injured Ramphal was declared to be dangerous to life.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner along with the other accused, had caused simple as well as grievous injuries to the members of the complainant-party with the deadly weapons held by them. As noticed above, injury No.1 on the person of Ramphal was declared dangerous to life. Thus, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary.

No case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
