Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the writ petition, respondents have passed an order dated 01.05.2019 (Annexure R-2), whereby the petitioner has been reinstated in service as Punjabi Master on notional basis with effect from the date his co-accused in the criminal case, Shri Mandeep Singh, has been reinstated by the Director, Public Instructions (Elementary Education), Punjab.

In the light of the above, counsel states that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is prayed for to challenge the order dated 01.05.2019 (Annexure R-2) denying the petitioner the consequential benefits on his reinstatement from 30.11.2015/move an application to put-forth his claim for the grant of consequential benefits from the date of his reinstatement.

Dismissed as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
