The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent No. 4.

It has been averred that the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 is 13.4.1994 while date of birth of petitioner No. 2 is 1.10.2001. Copies of Aadhar Cards showing date of birth of petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 2 are attached as Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively.

It has been submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 6.12.2020 according to Hindu rites at Maa Bala Sundri Jyotish Kendra, Booth No. 88, MDC, Sector 4, Panchkula. The marriage certificate is attached as Annexure P-3. Private respondent No. 4 is opposing to the marriage, as the petitioners had performed the marriage without his consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 6.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No. 2 Superintendent of Police, Panchkula seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondent.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in

Lata Singh Versus State of U.P. and another, 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
