The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner has prayed for issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents for protecting her life, liberty and property from being invaded by the private respondents by alleging that civil dispute is pending in respect of ramp installed outside the property of the petitioner. Two civil suits are pending against the petitioner in the civil Court at Amritsar.

Petitioner has also alleged the instance of physical assault upon her by the private respondents i.e. respondents No.4 to 8 by forcibly entering into the house and tearing her clothes. A criminal complaint is also pending in the trial Court. Petitioner has also alleged that flower bed constructed outside

her house has been demolished by the private respondents on 25.06.2020. In respect of ongoing grouse of the petitioner, she has already approached respondent No.3 for taking lawful action against the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Hittan Nehra, Addl.A.G.Punjab accepts notice on behalf respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response from the respondents as no order prejudicial to interest of any party is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to have a fair look on the representation filed by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact recorded herein above.
