This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by the petitioner for quashing of order dated 06.01.2012 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya, whereby he was declared proclaimed offender in FIR No.46 dated 05.05.2009, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC, Police Station, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel that the petitioner was on bail and left India during the pendency of the proceedings of the trial. He fairly states that no permission from the court was sought by the petitioner, before leaving India. It is also not disputed that presently also, the petitioner is residing abroad.

Considering the above facts and the conduct of the petitioner, this Court does not find any reason to entertain the petition for exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
