GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J.(Oral)

Petitioner-Jugpreet Singh stated to be aged about 30 years has filed present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for setting aside the order dated 25.11.2020 (Annexure P-5) passed by Ld. Principal Judge Family Court, Barnala whereby the petitioner is directed to record his statement through Video Conferencing for second motion identified by the concerned Embassy may kindly be set aside and petitioner may kindly be allowed to record his statement through Video Conferencing.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Nisha accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner based on pleadings submit that petitioner and respondent had jointly filed the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage with mutual consent.

The grievance of the petitioner is that vide order dated 25.11.2020, learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Barnala had allowed the petitioner to record his statement through Video Conferencing. However, a condition has been put that the statement should be recorded duly identified through concerned Embassy of Canada.

Learned counsel for respondent also supports the plea of the petitioner.

This Court finds no infirmity in the order dated 25.11.2020. However, accepting the request of the respective counsels, it is directed that the Principal Judge, Family Court, Barnala may proceed with the matter by allowing petitioner No.1 to be duly identified by petitioner No.2 and proceed to pass further orders in accordance with law.

With the above observation, the present petition is disposed of.
