The petitioner is allegedly an association of unaided private schools in the State of Haryana. The prayer made in the present writ petition is that the Director Secondary Education and Director Elementary Education be restrained from demanding details in Form 6 and further for directions to the State to enact an appropriate law regulating the maximum fee for unaided private schools.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner but he has not been able to satisfy the Court regarding the prejudice caused to the members of the petitioner by supplying details sought for in Form 6. Regarding the second prayer, the State Legislature may enact any law in its wisdom but it cannot be subjected to a mandamus by the Court.

3. The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
