The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 122 dated 06.05.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 188, 269, 270, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 307 IPC added later on) besides Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who was unarmed, has not been attributed any specific injury. The injuries, for which offence punishable under Section 307 IPC has been invoked, are attributed to co-accused.

This Court, by the order dated 10.12.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 10.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
