Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3, to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of private respondents.

The status report has not been filed by the learned State counsel, however, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, has apprised the Court that an FIR No.300 under Sections 363 and 366-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar stands registered against petitioner No. 1.

In the circumstances, when petitioner No. 1 admittedly is an accused in aforementioned FIR with respect to the kidnapping and abduction of petitioner No.2, no ground is made out to issue any directions

as prayed for by the learned counsel for the petitioner, therefore, the present petition is hereby dismissed as such.
