The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus restraining the official respondents from deliberately obstructing the services provided by the petitioner firm for getting the various registrations and other documentation work in the office of respondent no.3.

It has been asserted that the petitioner firm is working as service provider/agent to the transporters and traders for submitting documents under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

On 10.12.2020, Mr. Samarth Sagar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, was requested to take instructions. Today, after taking instructions from Mr. Vijay Kumar, TVF, Regional Transport Authority, Gurugram, he has stated that the documents submitted by the petitioner are being entertained. He submits that, although, there was some disturbance

due to various factors, however, the difficulties have been sorted out and all applications which are in order and submitted in accordance with law by anyone are being entertained.

In view of the aforesaid statement, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition be disposed of.
