Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members guaranteed under Article 21 of the Constitution of India, as they are apprehending threats from respondents No.3 to 6.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide their representation dated 12.10.2020 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural to look into the representation dated 12.10.2020 (Annexure P-3) at the earliest and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one month to ensure

that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.

6. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
