The petitioners are employees of Nagar Panchayat, Rampura. They have filed the present petition apprehending that Nagar Panchayat, Rampura, stands de-notified. Their apprehension arises from communication dated 2.12.2019 and 29.10.2020. Vide notification dated 29.10.2020, objections to the proposed de-notification of Nagar Panchayat, Rampura were invited. The petitioners are alleged to have submitted their objections.

Apprehension of the writ petitioners is further fortified from the fact that the State Government has issued notification dated 27.11.2020 in exercise of powers conferred under Section 13-A of Punjab Municipal Act, 1911, deciding to hold general and bye elections to elect the members of the Municipal Council/ Nagar Panchayat, however, Nagar Panchayat, Rampura has not been included.

Sh. Chawla, learned DAG, Punjab, has stated that, as of now, there is no de-notification of Nagar Panchayat, Rampura as the same is still under consideration. He submits that before de-notifying, the procedure as prescribed in law shall be followed.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of.
