1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite stay of operation of order of transfer dated 07.03.2019, the petitioner was relieved from his place of posting, therefore, respondent No.2 is liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 13.03.2019 in CWP No.6855 of 2019.

3. Issue notice to respondent No.2 to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against him for intentional and willful disobedience of order dated 13.03.2019 in CWP No.6855 of 2019.

4. Mr. R.K.S. Brar, learned Addl. A.G, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and has produced copy of order dated 10.12.2020, cancelling the order of transfer dated 27.11.2020 and restoring the position as existed on stay of operation of transfer order

thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed.
