This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 14.10.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/7, but still no action has been taken.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Bhupinder Beniwal, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, to look into and decide representation dated 14.10.2020 (Annexure P/7) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
