Learned counsel for the petitioner states that alongwith the reply of respondents No.1 to 7, they have appended an order passed in the year 2017, by which the petitioner has been imposed punishment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to challenge the said punishment order as the punishment has been imposed contrary to the settled principle of law as well as the rules governing the service, so that in case the petitioner is successful in that regard, he can also claim the interest on the delayed release of pensionary benefits.
