Gurdeep Singh and another Vs. Daljit Singh and others

Vide order dated 22.11.2019 on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹3,00,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the respondent No.2 has stated that the respondent no.2 has agreed to enhance the compensation only by ₹2,75,000/- and not by ₹3,00,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter offer of the respondent no.2.

We dispose of this case with a direction to respondent No.2 to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹2,75,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs seventy five thousand only) in the name of the appellant No.1-Gurdeep Singh son of Hardial Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 06.03.2020. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

It is made clear that if the payment of compensation is not made to the appellant-claimant within the prescribed time, he will be at liberty to revive this petition.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
