The petitioners have passed their senior secondary school examination from a Madrasa in Bihar and have been granted certificates by Bihar State Madrasa Education Board, Patna. Their grievance is that they

were granted admission in the Diploma Elementary Education Course of the State of Haryana but subsequently their admissions were cancelled as the board from which senior secondary certificate was obtained was not recognized by the State of Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that fee was charged from the petitioners but their admissions having been cancelled, they were not permitted to undergo the course. Thus, they may be permitted to withdraw present writ petitions with liberty to approach the respondent No.4 for refund of their fee.

3. Accordingly, writ petitions are permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.4 for refund of their fee by way of a written representation within a period of four weeks from today. In case, such a representation is filed, a speaking order be passed thereupon after hearing the petitioners within a further period of four weeks.
