This writ petition has been filed for setting aside order dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P33) passed by the learned Registrar General of Societies Haryana dismissing the petitioner's appeal against order dated 27.09.2018 passed by the learned State Registrar. The petitioner also seeks setting aside of order dated 27.09.2018 (Annexure P30), memos dated 14.09.2018 (Annexure P23), 19.09.2018 (Annexure P26) as well as 14.09.2018 (Annexure P25) and specifically the direction issued to the petitioner – Sabha to accept the nomination of respondent No. 4 as President and respondent No. 5 as Vice President in the election of the petitioner which was to be held as per Schedule 30.08.2018.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 4 and 5 at the outset submits that the said respondents are no longer desirous of contesting the elections to the post of President and Vice President of the petitioner – Sabha. It is, thus, submitted that in this view of the matter, the present writ petition is rendered infructuous.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous.

Needless to say, election to the petitioner – Sabha has been hanging fire since 2015, therefore, the election process be carried out in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
