The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim bail pending trial for two weeks in the case/ FIR No.46 dated 23.05.2018 under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Khamano, Tehsil and District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab, to attend the Barsi of his father on dated 18.12.2020 (Bhog on 20th December) (Annexure P.3).

It is pointed by learned State Counsel that the father of the petitioner had expired four years ago. Therefore, the petitioner is not required to be out of custody for performing any rituals on account of death

of his father after four years.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to grant interim bail to the petitioner.
