The petitioner-Hero Cycles Limited has filed the present petition *inter alia* with the prayer to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus granting permission to the Management under Section 33(2)(b) of the Industrial Disputes Act for dismissal of respondent No.2.

The records of the case show that notice of motion was issued on 09.03.2017. Respondent No.2 had put in appearance. On 11.12.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court the order dated 07.03.2019 passed by the President Officer, noticing that the parties have entered into a compromise to settle the matter. The photocopy of the said order has been handed over to the Court. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

Let the notice of the present proceedings be brought to the notice of the counsel for the respondents

so that the writ petition can be disposed of on the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 20.02.2020.”

Today, on resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the order dated 07.03.2019, passed by the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Ludhiana, wherein, statement of respondent No.2 has been recorded, in which, it has been observed that respondent No.2 relinquished his right of reinstatement and re-employment. The amount stated in the statement has already been paid to him.

In view of the statement, no further orders are called for.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of.
