This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks a writ of certiorari for quashing the result dated 01.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) and the entire selection process carried out for the post of Lecturer in Civil Engineering.

Counsel on a query having been put concedes that pursuant to the selection process having culminated even appointment letters have been issued.

Even though a selection process has been put to challenge but for certain strange reasons the selected and appointed candidates have not been arrayed as party respondents.

Writ petition suffers from the basic defect of non-joining of necessary parties. None of the selected/appointed candidates have even been

arrayed as respondents in a representative capacity.

Under such circumstances prayer made in the instant petition cannot be accepted.

Dismissed.
