This is the second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.80 dated 19.07.2018 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sirhind, Tehsil and District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was released on interim bail by this Court vide order dated 24.10.2019. Subsequently, vide order dated 25.11.2019 in CRM-36340-2019, the interim bail was extended and is continuing till date. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is HIV positive and Hepatitis C Virus positive. He has referred to the Medial Status Report (Annexure A-2) filed by the State with the affidavit of Superintendent, New District Jail, Nabha.

Learned State counsel has not been able to dispute this fact.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.10.2019, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
