The petitioner has filed this writ petition for directions to respondent No. 1 to correct his date of birth in the certificate of secondary school examination which was passed in the year 2010.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that according to his birth certificate, his date of birth is 25.01.1994 whereas in the secondary school examination certificate, it has been recorded as 13.11.1994. Thus, the date of birth be corrected.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 submits that the first application seeking correction of date of birth is dated 20.01.2017. As per Rules, for correction of date of birth annexed as Annexure R-1 with the written statement no application for correction can be entertained after five years from the issuance of secondary school examination certificate. Thus, no action can be taken upon the application moved by the petitioner.

In view of the aforementioned Rule regarding correction of date of birth in the secondary school examination certificate, no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly, dismissed.
