The petitioner, an Anganwari Worker, seeks transfer from Village Kera Khera, Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka, to Pothi Mala, Ward No.7, Center No.1 in Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur, on personal grounds. According to her, two Anganwari Workers were promoted as Supervisors and vacancies are available. Her complaint is that the authorities are not taking any action upon her request for such transfer, despite her representations dated 10.06.2019, 24.10.2020 and 07.11.2020.

As it is for the authorities concerned to consider the petitioner's request for transfer, keeping in mind the availability of a vacancy and also

administrative exigencies, it would be appropriate that the petitioner's representations are taken into consideration and acted upon.

Ms. Anju Arora, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, would assure this Court that necessary action would be taken by the authorities in this regard, given sufficient time.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the respondent authorities to consider the petitioner's request for transfer, in terms of her representations dated 10.06.2019, 24.10.2020 and 07.11.2020, and take appropriate action thereon. In the event her request is rejected, the authorities shall pass a detailed reasoned order and communicate the same to her. The entire exercise, one way or the other, shall be completed expeditiously and in any event, not later than two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
