This revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking setting aside of the order dated 28.08.2020 passed by the Land Acquisition Collector while dismissing an application under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in view of the order dated 10.12.1992 passed in CR-1091-1992 (Annexure P-9), the Collector was required to decide the application on merits. Hence, he submits that the Collector has erred in dismissing the application under Section 28-A.

After arguing for sometime and realizing that the order dated 10.12.1992 was never brought to the notice of the Land Acquisition Collector, he prays for permission to withdraw the revision petition with

liberty to file an application before Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate, Gurugram in this regard.

Keeping in view the aforesaid prayer, revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the above-stated order.
