The grievance of the petitioner is that juniors have been promoted to the rank of senior XEN and his candidature has been withheld on account of pendency of disciplinary proceedings. The disciplinary proceedings have been pending since September 2018 and delay in conclusion thereof is prejudicially affecting the petitioner. Thus, a direction may be issued to conclude the same expeditiously.

The prayer is reasonable and is accepted. In view of the prayer and the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice of motion.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to conclude the pending disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible and in any case, not later than three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
