The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.248 dated 08.12.2018 registered under Sections 22, 61 of the NDPS Act (Sections 25, 29, 61 of the NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Maur Mandi, District Bathinda.

Petitioner was one of the co-occupants of the car and was sitting on the back seat of the car in question along with Manoj Kumar.

It is not in dispute that co-accused have been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 27.11.2020 passed in CRM-M No.15574 of 2020, CRM-M No.21640 of 2019 and anticipatory bail passed in CRM-M No.3242 of 2019.

For the detailed reasons recorded in the aforesaid petitions, this petition is also disposed of. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Copy of the order dated 27.11.2020 passed in CRM-M No.15574 of 2020 shall form part of the order as well.
