The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure entrusting the investigation of FIR No. 114 dated 08.06.2020 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar, Nabha, District Patiala to Central Bureau of Investigation/SIT or some independent agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that subsequent to the order dated 10.09.2020 passed by this Court, representation dated 14.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) was made to respondent No. 2-Director General of Police, Punjab by the petitioner, however, no steps/appropriate action has been taken by him in this regard. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 for taking a decision on the representation dated 14.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, is directed to look into the representation dated 14.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps/action, if any required in accordance with law.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
