Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.151, dated 29.07.2018 registered under Section 21 and 27-A of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

The counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the order dated 04.09.2019 passed in CRM-M-15437 of 2019, ***Balak Singh Versus State of Punjab***.

Vide order dated 04.09.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwant Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the order dated 04.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
