This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action against respondents No.4 and 5 on the complaints made by petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations dated 08.09.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali and respondent No.3-Director General of Police, Punjab Police, Chandigarh, copies of which are available on the file as Annexure P/4 and P/5 respectively, but still no action has been taken.

At the asking of Court, Mr.B.S.Sewak, Additional Advocate General Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), to look into and decide representation dated 08.09.2020 (Annexure P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
