The petitioner, who was serving in the rank of Assistant Municipal Engineer with the Department of Local Bodies, Punjab had filed the instant petition assailing his transfer vide impugned order dated 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) from Nagar Council Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar to Nagar Council, Nabha District Patiala.

The primary ground of challenge was that the transfer has been directed on the verge of his retirement and as such, being against the Transfer Policy.

Instant petition had come up for preliminary hearing on 3.12.2018 and while issuing notice of motion, transfer of the petitioner had been stayed.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from Dinesh Kumar, Senior Assistant, DLG, informs the Court that the petitioner has since superannuated on 30.11.2019 during the subsistence of the transfer order.

Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute such factual premise.

In view of the above, nothing would survive for adjudication in the instant petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
