Petitioner has approached this Court praying for the grant of the revised higher scale of Rs.4020-6200/- being ITI qualified and holding post on re-designation as a Technician along with grade pay of Rs.2800/- w.e.f. 01.12.2011, as per the Punjab Government instructions, as similarly placed employees i.e. Plumbers including Anil Kumar, Government Rajindra Hospital, Patiala, has been granted the said benefit.

In the reply which has been filed by the respondents, it has been stated that the claim of the petitioner has been considered and he has been re-designated as Junior Technician as he is ITI pass, however, he has been granted the grade pay of Rs.2400/-. Copy of the order passed by the Medical Superintendent, Guru Gobind Singh Medical Hospital, Faridkot-respondent No.3, dated 22.11.2018 has been appended as Annexure R-1/T.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the present writ petition

may be disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents in case he has still any grievance with regard to his claim regarding grade pay of Rs.2800/- instead of Rs.2400/-.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to the Medical Superintendent, Guru Gobind Singh Medical Hospital, Faridkot-respondent No.3 within a period of four weeks from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by the Medical Superintendent, Guru Gobind Singh Medical Hospital, Faridkot-respondent No.3 at an early date and in any case, within a period of two months from the date of submission of such representation. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the other consequential benefits in accordance with law be released to him as per his entitlement.
