The petitioner has filed this petition being aggrieved by the manner of allotment of seats and violation of the NRI quota by the respondents while granting admission to MBBS course.

When confronted with clause 13 of the admission process and regulations dealing with the provision of appeal to be filed before the Director, Research and Medical Education, Punjab in case of any dispute relating to admission, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file an appeal today itself.

Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab submits that as the admission process is not over and the counselling is going on, in case such an appeal is filed by the petitioner, the appellate authority concerned shall consider and take a decision thereon before finalizing the admission process.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
