The petitioner has approached this Court, praying for quashing of the notifications dated 03.12.2020 and 30.10.2019 (Annexures P-11 and P-10 respectively), issued by the respondents against the violation of the judgment and direction issued by this Court in CWP-19822-2018 titled as Dalip Kumar and another vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-7).

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the notifications impugned by the petitioner have been passed in violation of the order dated 19.12.2018, passed by the Division Bench of this Court in Dalip Kumar's case (supra).

Be that as it may, the petitioner would have availed remedy available to him in accordance with law for violation of the said order. The present writ petition which has been preferred by the petitioner is barred as notification dated 03.12.2020 (Annexure P-11) stands issued for the

elections. That being the position, the writ petition being not maintainable.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would avail remedy of contempt in accordance with law.

This contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner, if permissible in law by passing of this order will not bar his said remedy.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed with above observations.
