Case is taken up through Video Conferencing on account of
COVID-2019.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in
case FIR No.245, dated 1.8.2020, registered under Sections 379 B, 34 IPC
(Section 411 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Kapurthala, District
Kapurthala.

FIR was lodged on the statement of Jaspal Singh stating that on
1.8.2020, at about 10.30 am he was going to work by walking. On the way,
3 young men who were on motorcycle snatched his mobile phone. When they
attempted to flee away, their motorcycle fell down. They ran away leaving the
motorcycle at spot. He identified the petitioner as being one of them.

The investigation in case is complete and challan has been filed.
Petitioner is in custody since 03.08.2020. The trial of case has not made any
headway because of COVID 2019.

In view thereof, no useful purpose will be served by detaining
petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of trial. Accordingly, petition is

allowed. Petitioner-*Sagar Kumar* is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
