1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail and the learned trial Court being directed to consider and the decide the application for regular bail expeditiously.
3. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.
4. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, with the liberty as prayed for. Needless to mention, in case an application for regular bail is moved by the petitioner, the learned trial court shall consider and decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one week.
