AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has approached this Court making a grievance that the respondents are not transferring the plot in the name of the petitioner which was initially allotted to his mother namely Smt. Prem Mohini Jain who unfortunately died.

The petitioner had been approaching respondent No.2-Estate Officer, Haryana Shehri Vikas Parishad, Sector 6 Panchkula, Haryana for redressal of his grievance and for transfer of the plot which was allotted to his mother, being the legal heir as there was a registered Will in his favour. Even the legal heir certificate, indemnity bond and other necessary documents were supplied by the petitioner to respondent No.2. Despite various representations and visits, made by the petitioner, the claim of the petitioner, as projected in the writ petition and the representation, has not

been accepted till date. Reference has been made by the petitioner to the representations, copies of which have been placed on record as Annexure P-16 to P-19. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner shall file a detailed comprehensive representation to respondent No.2-Estate Officer, Haryana Shehri Vikas Parishad, Panchkula within a period of one week which may be considered and decided at an early date.

Learned counsel for the respondents, Mr. Sanjeev Majha, Advocate who puts in appearance, accepts the request of the counsel for the petitioner and states that decision will be taken by the competent authority in case the petitioner moves a representation within a period of one week.

Without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as projected in the representation, to be submitted by him within a period of one week. In case such representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided within a period of six weeks from the date of submission of that representation.
