All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks for issuance of a writ in the nature of '*mandamus*' directing respondents no. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to restrain respondents no. 5 and 6 from harassing him and from interfering in his peaceful life.

The petitioner is alleged to have been harassed at the hands of respondents no. 5 and 6, of whom respondent no. 6 is stated to be an ASI in Police Station Kharar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite representations having been filed before the SSP Mohali, no action is being taken.

She further submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the SSP to look into the grievance of the petitioner and to take action as per law.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of what is contended, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the SSP, SAS Nagar (Mohali) (respondent no. 2) to go into the grievance of the petitioner and to take action as is warranted as per law by passing an order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
