The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.157 dated 10.10.2018 registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot under Sections 420, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 2.9.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridkot has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Arminder Singh and Kanwaljit Kaur and also of

complainant Gurdarshan Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves with the intervention of respectables and Panchayat.

The complainant in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridkot has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.157 dated 10.10.2018 registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot under Sections 420, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
