Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.58 dated 30.07.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 30.08.2019 passed by this Court, on joint request of both the sides, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the petitioner and the complainant were directed to appear on 25.09.2019. The report of Mediator was awaited for 22.11.2019 and it was ordered that in the meanwhile, no coercive means shall be adopted against the petitioner.

A report dated 02.12.2019 has been received from the Mediator, wherein it is mentioned that the parties have settled their dispute amicably by way of the settlement/agreement dated 02.12.2019.

Learned counsel for the complainant has not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediator, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.08.2019, whereby it was ordered that no coercive means shall be adopted against the petitioner, is made absolute.

The settlement/agreement dated 02.12.2019 be made part of the record and the parties shall adhere to its terms and conditions in letter and spirit. In case of non-compliance of the terms and conditions of the settlement/agreement by either party, the aggrieved party shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be served upon him.
