GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.210, dated 3.3.2017, Police Station City Jind, under Sections 323, 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of Medicare Service Persons and Medicare Service Institutions (Prevention of violence and damage of property) Act, 2008 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 7.11.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

3. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jind, has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Poonam, Ashok Kumar Ahlawat and also of complainant Dr. Sonal Singal and affected persons Sunil Kumar, Pooja have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
4. The complainant and affected persons in their statement have specifically stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jind, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.210, dated 3.3.2017, Police Station City Jind, under Sections 323, 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of Medicare Service Persons and Medicare Service Institutions (Prevention of violence and damage of property) Act, 2008 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
