CM-642-CII-2016 and CM-643-CII-2016

Prayer in the applications is for condonation of delay of 786
days in re-filing the appeal and 245 days in filing the appeal.

Notice of the applications was issued on 26.10.2018. As per
office report, service is complete. No response has been filed. Counsel
representing contesting respondent No. 3 does not have any objection to the
prayer made in the applications.

Accordingly, both the applications are allowed. Delay in filing
and re-filing the appeal is condoned.

FAO No. 233 of 2016

Mr. Arvind Kumar Yadav, Advocate for the claimants-

appellants concedes that the parties have entered into an oral compromise

and the appellants have agreed to accept Rs. 3,50,000/- inclusive of interest over and above the compensation amount awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Narnaul, which has already been received by the appellants-claimants along with interest. He has filed a copy of affidavit dated 11.09.2020 of appellant No. 4-Smt. Krishana Devi, wife of Jagdish Parshad, who has admitted the factum of oral compromise with the Insurance Company-respondent No. 3. Ms. Swati Batra, Advocate, who is representing the Insurance Company-respondent No.3, has referred to the joint application (CM No.8183-CII-2020) and affidavit of Sh. Suryadeep Singh Thakur, Manager, Reliance General Insurance Company Limited, to affirm the compromise.

Accordingly, in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, the appeal is disposed of and respondent No. 3- Insurance Company shall pay an additional amount of Rs. 3,50,000/- to the appellant(s)-claimant(s) within a period of four weeks from the date of this order, by way of ECS transfer to the bank account(s).
