The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and personal liberty of the petitioner from being invaded by respondents No.4 to 9.

Petitioner has already filed a complaint to the police on the premise that the petitioner has been cheated by the private respondents. FIR No.149 dated 13.09.2020 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC has already been registered in Police Station City Jalalabad, but still the police has not taken any action and the private respondents are threatening the petitioner to compromise the matter.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has already moved a representation to respondent No.2 on 03.12.2020 which is still pending.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Harpreet S. Multani, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling any response as no order prejudicial to the interest of any party is being passed.

In view of above, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation filed by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact recorded herein above. It would be appreciated if the representation filed by the petitioner is decided within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
